

# CONSIDERING T LEVELS?

Check out the top 5 reasons to study for a T Level:

1. **CREATED WITH BUSINESS** T Levels have been designed with leading businesses and employers to give you the knowledge and skills you need.
2. **LEARN YOUR WAY** T Levels involve more classroom study than apprenticeships, which means you can experience an industry while you continue your studies.
3. **GET AHEAD IN YOUR CAREER** They give you the chance to learn what a real career is like while you continue your studies, by including a 45 day work placement.
4. **QUALIFICATIONS THAT COUNT** When you pass your T Level, you will get a nationally recognised certificate showing the overall grade you achieved - pass, merit, distinction or distinction\*. It will also give details of what you learned on the course to help you move into skilled employment or a higher apprenticeship.
5. **AWARDED UCAS POINTS** A T Level will be worth UCAS points – a T Level Distinction\* is worth the same as 3 A levels at A\* – and will be recognised by universities and other education providers so you can choose to continue studying if you wish.
